Food Plot and Cover



Red Clover- \$30.00/half acre

Tasty and nutritious wildlife feed that stays green into the winter providing a late season feed source. Plant April – May in moderate to well drained soils with a pH of 6.5-7.5. Germinates in 7-10 days and will grow 18"-30" tall at maturity. Plant 5lbs per $\frac{1}{2}$ acre.

White Clover- \$40.00/half acre

Puts out large leaves and also stays green long into the winter. Provides a good feed source for deer, turkey, partridge and grouse. Can be planted February – April or August – September in a wide range of soil types with a pH of 5.5-7.0. Will germinate in 7-10 days and grow 3"-24" tall and stands will last 2-10 years. Plant 2.5lbs per ½ acre.

Radish-\$30.00/half acre

Late flowering Daikon radish that produce large leafy tops and deep bulbs for wildlife to forage on in the late fall. Grows well in a wide range of soil types, plant early August to September in soils with a pH of 6.0-7.0. Will germinate in 4-6 days and reach 2'-3' tall at maturity. Mixes well with small grains and grasses. Plant 3.5lbs per ½ acre.

Purple Top Turnip- \$30.00/half acre

A high quality high yielding feed source for summer or fall that will stay green long into the winter as well. Plant March – April or in August in a wide range of soils types with a pH of 5.5-7.0. Germinates in 5-7 days and can grow 2'-3' at maturity. Also mixes well with small grains. Plant 2.5lbs per $\frac{1}{2}$ acre.

Dwarf Essex Rape- \$6.00/half acre

A large leaf, high quality forage type plant that provides an excellent feed source for deer, turkeys and rabbits long into the winter. Plant in August in a variety of soil types with a soil pH of 5.5-7.0. Will germinate in 5-7 days and can grow 3'-4' high at maturity. Plant 2.5lbs per $\frac{1}{2}$ acre.

Forage Sorghum- \$12.00/half acre

An annual grass type plant with a high sugar, juicy stalk. Can grow 5'-8' tall providing excellent cover. Capable of growing in a wide range of soil types with a pH of 6.0-7.0, planted May-July. Plant 5lbs per ½ acre.

Grain Sorghum- \$10.00/half acre

An annual grass type plant that grows a grain head and produces a grain with a feed value similar to corn but only growing 3'-4' tall. The grain becomes more palatable throughout the fall. Also grows in a wide range of soil types with a pH of 6.0-6.5. Plant May-August at 5lbs per $\frac{1}{2}$ acre.

Sorghum Mix- \$15.00/half acre

An excellent mix of short grain type sorghums and tall forage type sorghums. Provides excellent cover and the grain is a good source of feed for pheasant, quail, and turkey.
